

**LOUISVILLE LIONS CUB CLUB  
PERMIT TO ADMINISTER MEDICATION**

In order for Cub Club Director or Assistant Director to administer medication to a student, it is necessary to have written permission from a parent or guardian. A permit is required for the dispensing of ANY medication, including Tylenol and other over-the-counter type medications. The following conditions must be met before a medication will be dispensed:

1. A signed permit is submitted to the Director or Assistant Director.
2. Prescription medication to be administered must be in a prescription bottle, properly labeled, including: child's name, physician's name, name of medication, and directions for administering. Your pharmacist will provide you with an extra medication bottle upon request.
3. Over-the-counter medications must be in original manufacturer's container with child's name written on the bottle.
4. No medications will be administered past their expiration date.

I give permission Louisville Cub Club Director or Assistant Director or in an absolute emergency (if both the Director and Assistant Director are not available), an adult staff member may administer medication after the Director has been notified.
